ORDINANCE NO. 299

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE, LOUISIANA
PROVIDING FOR ALL MATTERS RELATING TO
MANAGING THE YOUNGSVILLE FLOODPLAIN**

WHEREAS, the City of Youngsville has always utilized the Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) to manage the Youngsville Floodplain which includes utilization of Map Numbers 220550065 G, 220550070 G, 220550075 G, 220550080 G which all had an effective date of January 19th, 1996;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned maps designate the Youngsville Incorporated limits as Zone A whereas Zone A is a Special Flood Hazard Area Inundated by 100-yr Flood and no base flood elevations have been determined.

WHEREAS, the City of Youngsville has entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government: relating to collaborative funding for the Floodplain Management Services Agreement (FPMS) between the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Lafayette Consolidated Government for the LINC Comprehensive Drainage and Stormwater Plan for the Parish of Lafayette;

WHEREAS, the City of Youngsville is desirous to better manage its floodplain for the benefit of all of the citizens of Youngsville and have identified the Drainage and Stormwater Element as a critical priority for the parish;

WHEREAS, as a result of the aforementioned Intergovernmental Agreement, the Preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps, dated September 28, 2007, including Map Number, 22055C0170J, 22055C0200J, 22055C0250J, 22055C0275J, have been developed and are attached;

WHEREAS, the provisions of 44 Code of Federal Regulations 60.3(b)(4) require that the City of Youngsville “*Obtain, review and reasonably utilize any base flood elevation and floodway data available from a Federal, State, or other source....*” and this Federal Regulation mandates the City of Youngsville utilize the data from a the preliminary Flood Insurance Study;

NOW, THEREFORE the Mayor and City Council of the City of Youngsville agree that the City of Youngsville will utilize the Preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps, dated September 28, 2007, Map Number 22055C0170J, 22055C0200J, 22055C0250J, 22055C0275J to manage the floodplain within the City of Youngsville. ;

WHEREUPON, this ordinance is hereby adopted at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Mayor and the City Council for the City of Youngsville on this 8th day of November, 2007.

SECTION 2: This ordinance to become effective on the _____ day of _____, 2007 in compliance with L.S.A.R.S. 33:173.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof in conflict are hereby repealed.
